

## Reporting Violations of Public Act 188

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If you observe or note a possible violation, please notify the owner or manager of the establishment when feasible, and give them the opportunity to take the appropriate steps to resolve the situation before a formal complaint is filed. If the violation is not resolved, you can report the violation for further action. You may complete the complaint form on the website: [www.michigan.gov/smokefreelaw](http://www.michigan.gov/smokefreelaw) and submit it to the appropriate enforcement agency for the county in which the violation occurred. The Enforcement Contact List, also provided on this website, lists the contact agency by county for filing complaints. Please review the Enforcement Contact List to ensure you are taking the appropriate steps and contacting the correct enforcement agency to report violations of the law. Please note, in some cases for worksites that are non-foodservice establishments, the enforcement agency is the Michigan Department of Community Health.

Please note:

- \* Complaints are a matter of public record and confidentiality cannot be guaranteed.
- \* Information entered in the complaint form, including your name, will be provided to local health departments/MDCH so they have the necessary information to follow up on complaints.
- \* If you do not want to leave your name and contact information, you can leave your complaint anonymously, but the local health department/MDCH will not be able to contact you if further information is required.
